

To change the number of nights for the hotel reservation:

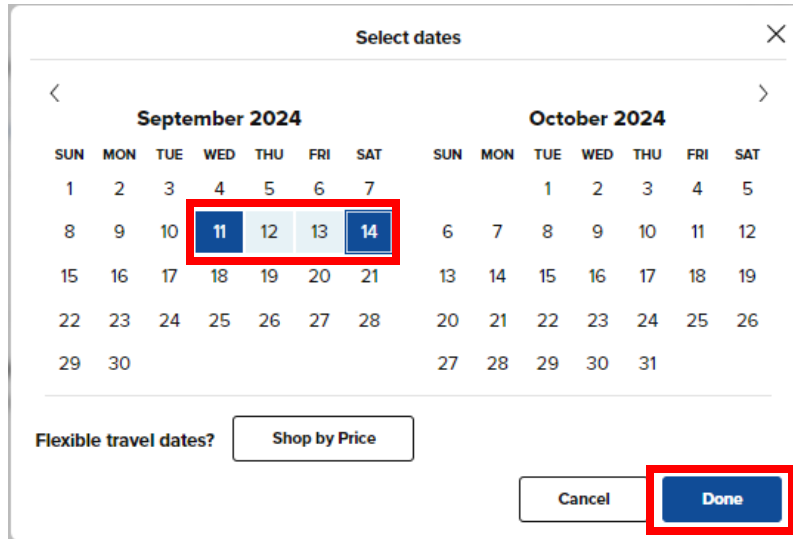
1. Click 'Edit Stay'

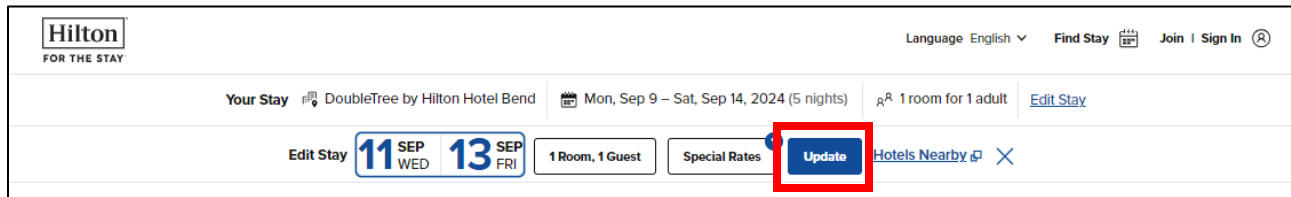
2. Click on the bold dates.
